Psalm 46:10

If so, you are not alone. There are all kinds of troubles on this earth, and many of us who are truly Christians sometimes doubt things. But let me tell you a story that has helped me.

I have long been praying for friends and family and even world situations. But I never gave it much thought really. I just prayed, over and over sometimes. At some point, I started a new habit. I put out a jar on the table and started writing out my prayer concerns and then with a little prayer of my own, I placed them in the jar and put the lid on it. My goal was to give them to God and then focus on my own daily tasks. Gradually the jar became full of my requests and I kept pushing them down to fit more into the jar. I called it "God's Job Jar."

At one point I thought, OK, enough is enough. I opened the jar and pulled out the requests one by one and reread them. My intention was to toss out the ones where the prayers had been answered. As I read them, I discovered something very important. Every one of my prayer requests has been handled by God. Everyone I had prayed for had either healed or a better decision had been made by God. Every one of them!

God does not always handle our concerns as we wish, but He always handles them in the way that He knows is best for everyone. God is with us every step of the way on our journey. We do not need to struggle. We just need to pray, be still, and know that God is with us and will take care of us and our fears.


